Position: **Crisis Clinician - CCBHC**

Salary Range: **\$42,016 - \$76,689.60 annualized, Exempt, Union Position**

Key Responsibilities and Accountabilities:

Mobile Crisis Clinician will provide crisis services to individuals in the community and clinic. Primary responsibilities will focus on the provision of crisis intervention services. This will include urgent response within the community to assist law enforcement and/or community members experiencing a mental health crisis. Tasks include the completion of pre-screen assessments for individuals presenting for inpatient placement; establishing placement for individuals requiring hospitalization, completing eligibility screens for determination of appropriate level of care support services, completing alternative orders, conducting psychosocial assessments, treatment planning and the facilitation of group therapy for individuals recently diverted or discharged out of psychiatric placement. As a member of Summit Pointe's Mobile Crisis team, the Crisis Clinician shall act in a leadership role within Summit Pointe and its community partners at assisting in situations of a mental/behavioral health crisis.

This individual will be expected to complete documentation according to agency guidelines and standards as well as in accordance with funding source regulations. Shall ensure compliance and participation with competency improvement activities including, but not limited to credentialing, continuing education requirements, and professional improvement practices. Demonstrates excellent organizational, communication, computer, analytical and problem-solving skills. Shall be self-directed and resourceful. Participates in corporate quality improvement and problem solving activities. Maintains confidentiality and privacy within MDHHS, state and federal guidelines. Utilizes knowledge of CARF, CMS, MDCH and Managed Care standards. Performs other duties as required.

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Qualifications and Capabilities: {EEO Screening Tool}

- Master's Degree in Psychology, Social Work or related field with Licensure in the State of Michigan as a Social Worker (LMSW/LLMSW); Limited Licensed Psychologist (LLP/TLLP); Professional Counselor (LPC/LLPC) mandatory. **Position requires CAADC Certification, but will allow applicants already on the certification development plan or will apply and start CAADC Certification development plan within 30 days from hire.**
- Two years of experience in behavioral health care setting providing clinical services, and/or psychological testing, and psychotherapy or the equivalent utilizing evidence based practices.
- Knowledge of psychotherapy, counseling, research methods, crisis intervention techniques, assessment and interview methods, and ability to coordinate programs and services essential. Knowledge of judicial system preferred.
- One year of computer experience – Word, Excel and electronic medical record software preferred.

Essential Functions:

This position will be knowledgeable about and actively support 1) culturally competent, recovery-based practices; 2) person-centered planning as a shared decision making process with the individual, who defines his/her own life goals and is assisted in developing a unique path toward those goals; and 3) a trauma informed culture to aid individuals in their recovery process.

Trauma Informed System of Care:

A trauma-informed approach to service delivery emphasizes physical and emotional safety, choice, empowerment, and trustworthiness for customers. The impact of trauma is broad and touches many life domains. Participation is mandatory for activities required for Summit Pointe to become a “Trauma Informed System of Care.”

Physical Environment/Work Conditions:

- Professional office environment that generates noise from computer equipment/peripherals.
- Possible exposure to health risks (violence and infectious diseases).
- Sometimes lifts, carries, or moves objects up to 25 lbs.
- May be required to work variable hours/shifts.

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
